This one-day professional development seminar is for allied health professionals that work with clients and carers who are living with CBD, MSA and PSP, and for other interested members of the health profession.

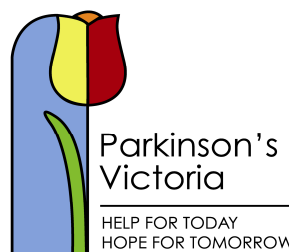
This day will provide an insight into these conditions, as well as practical advice and strategies for assisting patients and their carers.
